

How to obtain your FCC Registration Number (FRN):

NOTE: Your address on the license application must match that on the FRN, and the license address will become publicly available. If you have a privacy concern about providing a home address, you can use another address at which the FCC can contact you, for example, a P.O. box, work address, etc.

A) If you have an FCC (Federal Communication Commission) issued license of any kind, start at step B).

If you do not have any FCC issued License, start at step D).

If you do not have Internet Access, go to step F)

B) Locate your FCC account information:

If you have an FCC issued license, you may have been assigned an FRN and a password.

If you can still find that information skip to **Step 3**).

If you only know your FRN number, continue at Step F.

If you do not know your FRN, continue with Step C.

C) Search for your FRN

Go to <http://wireless.fcc.gov/>

In the Licensing section on the right of the screen, click on "License Search"

Type in your call sign, check the box "exact matches only" and then click "Search"

Your FRN, if one is assigned, will be displayed towards the center of the screen.

As an alternative, you may search by "Name", by using the pull-down box at the "By Call Sign" default field.

If you have an FRN, write it down and skip to Step F to get a password assigned.

D) Register to get a new FRN and password assigned (You need to have your Social Security Number (SSN) handy at this point).

Go to <http://wireless.fcc.gov/> and click on "FRN Registration"

Select the "Registration" field.

Answer questions appropriately and completely

E) Write down your FRN and your password

Fill out the form and click "Submit"

F) Contact FCC ULS Technical Support (If you do not have internet access, or have a problem which requires FCC assistance).

Call the FCC help desk at 1-877-480-3201. They are open M-F 8:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m. ET. Have all your information at hand to speed the call.

The support desk must talk directly with the licensee to confirm his or her identity. You can't do that for a third party.

Ask for the FRN and password to be conveyed to you by phone, if possible, so you can finish your filing. Store this information in a safe place for future use.
